OSSTF District 19 Location



Located just north of Hwy 401 and east of Hwy 10 (Hurontario)

401 Approach - Take Hwy 10 exit (Hurontario) north & go north.
Turn east (right) off Hwy 10 onto Annagem; go east to Edwards Blvd.

407 Approach - Take Hwy 10 exit (Hurontario) south & go south.
Turn east (left) off Hwy 10 onto Annagem; go east to Edwards Blvd.

410 Approach - Take exit for Courtney Park Dr. East & go west (right).
This exit is only available from the northbound 410 lanes.
Turn south off Courtney Park onto Edwards; go south to Annagem.
We are on the SE corner of Edwards and Annagem
on the main floor of Educators' Centre Bldg.
